Child Care Teachers are responsible for the development of Playing to Learn curriculum and direct program delivery within the established standards of the YMCA Child Behaviour Guidelines and the Day Nurseries Act.

Incumbents must have excellent interpersonal skills and an understanding and appreciation for the delivery of high quality child care services.

- Assist with children's meals and snacks including set up and clean up
- Available for various shifts including opening/closing the centre
- Liaise with parents of children
- Develop and implement Playing to Learn curriculum
