Your Guide to Financial Assistance at YMCA Wanakita

YMCA Wanakita offers opportunities for children and youth in need regardless of race, age, gender, creed, ability or economic circumstances. Children and youth participate in YMCA programs to grow and develop towards being happier, healthier more productive people.

The YMCA assistance program makes every effort to accommodate those individuals who have the greatest need to our communities.

Those who feel they qualify for assistance can contact us anytime to discuss participating in YMCA Wanakita programs.

Commonly Asked Questions

How does the YMCA determine how much I can afford to pay?

Your fee is based on your needs, financial capabilities, supporting financial documentation and an agreement that is acceptable to both you and the YMCA.

I could probably pay the full fee if I didn't have to pay it all at once. Are there other payment methods offered by the YMCA?

Yes. We recognize that many people are not able to afford the full fees all at once. That is why we have created a variety of different payment options, please refer to the payment plans on the registration forms for details.

If I receive YMCA Wanakita financial assistance, what is expected of me?

All information requested and provided by you will be kept confidential. We expect the same confidentiality from you. A YMCA financial assistance agreement also requires a commitment to making your payments on time and in full.

Can the YMCA deny my application for assistance?

Yes, in some cases this can happen. Based on availability of program space, willingness to pay the financial assistance determined as well as not providing all documentation requested. In some cases the demand for financial assistance exceeds the funds that are available. Again we consider the needs of all applicants equally.

How many "experiences" my I apply for at Wanakita?

Financial assistance is granted to children and youth on a program by program basis throughout one calendar year. However, we want to ensure that there is an equal opportunity for all in the community to participate. Therefore, first time applicants' may be considered before returning financial assisted applicant's.

Where does the money come from to support the YMCA Wanakita assistance program?

The YMCA Strong Kids Fund and the YMCA of Hamilton/Burlington.
