Nature and Scope:

YMCA Wanakita is seeking two Summer Kids Camp Assistant Directors. These positions are year-round roles focussing on preparation and delivery of YMCA Wanakita's Summer Kids Camp Program. During the summer, the Assistant Directors will help in providing guidance and support to Wanakita's team of Section Directors under the direction of the Summer Kids Camp Director. During the Fall, Winter and Spring the Assistant Directors will assist in program development, hiring & provide support to YMCA Wanakita's Outdoor Centre Programs. Successful applicants will be required to live on site during the summer season and on an as needed basis during the Spring, Fall and Winter seasons. A competitive room and board package is available to successful applicants.

Responsibilities:

Fall, Winter, Spring

- Facilitate and organize applicants during the hiring process (November-February)
- Research and develop programming from various sources to improve summer program quality & delivery
- Assist in creating & developing staff development sessions
- Assist in training and onboarding new staff in their roles
- Process summer seasonal staff employment packages
- Place campers into cabins and program areas with assistance from the registrar, ensuring registrations reflect program abilities and needs
- Support Outdoor Centre programs and ensure site and facilities are prepared for daily operation

- Facilitate camp programming and special events
- Deliver and facilitate staff training with a focus on program development
- Provide support and guidance to staff, maintaining accountability for both facility and camping best practices
- Staff management including regular evaluations, staff appreciation events and addressing staff behavior

YMCA Wanakita:

YMCA Wanakita, located in the Haliburton Highlands on Koshlong Lake, is a four season YMCA Camp and Outdoor Centre affiliated with the YMCA of

Hamilton/Burlington/Brantford. Situated 2 ½ hours north of Toronto on a beautiful forested 1000 acre site, Wanakita operates (for the 10 weeks in and around July and August) as a summer residential children's camp, a summer day camp and a summer family camp. From September to June, Wanakita operates as an Outdoor Education. Recreation and Retreat Centre for schools, colleges, universities, families, adults, businesses, clubs and other special interest groups. Wanakita currently serves over 150 different groups annually.

YMCA Wanakita maintains 130 buildings and has accommodation and dining for up to 700 people during the summer months and up to 250 in the winter; programs and equipment for swimming, canoeing, kayaking, sailing, cross country skiing, snow shoeing, high/low ropes courses, wilderness and environmental programs, crafts, performing arts and more. Wanakita offers outdoor experiences to over 13,000 participants annually. Currently employed are 12 full time staff members with seasonal staff support ranging from 18 - 180 employees. Over 250 volunteers a year are also involved in Wanakita's success.
