Hours of work will be from Sunday to Thursday, including early mornings, days, and evenings, on rotational schedule and arranged in advance.

- Provides day-to-day coordination of swim lesson program, which includes being present on deck during swim lessons.

- Responsible for supervising Aquatics Team during all swim lessons and will be scheduled accordingly.
- Responsible for scheduling and leading Aquatics training.

- Must be able to enter the pool at all times to assist members/program participants in case of emergency.
- In consultation with the Aquatics Manager, ensure report cards are delivered as per the annual schedule and provide leadership to ensure quality is achieved.
