You will also collaborate closely with a supportive team of staff and volunteers, maintain a clean and safe pool environment, and uphold all health and safety standards. This position offers opportunities for professional growth through ongoing training, certification upgrades, and leadership development.

Aquatic team members work a variety of shifts including morning, evening, weekends, and public holidays and are scheduled based on the needs of the branch.

- **Lifeguarding and Safety Oversight:** The primary responsibility is to provide consistent lifeguard coverage, ensuring the safety of all pool users. This includes upholding YMCA policies and health regulations while delivering excellent customer service to members and participants.
- **Aquatic Program Instruction and Coaching:** The role involves teaching, guarding, and coaching a variety of aquatic programs. Staff are expected to develop lesson plans, conduct progressive evaluations, and maintain accurate records related to instruction and participant progress.
- **Facility and Equipment Maintenance:** Experience with pool chemicals and cleaning supplies is essential for maintaining water quality and deck equipment. Staff are responsible for ensuring the cleanliness and safety of the aquatic environment.
- **Team Collaboration and Professional Development:** Working collaboratively with other staff and volunteers in the aquatic area is key. Employees must also maintain current certifications, attend scheduled training sessions, and pursue ongoing professional development as required.

- Lifesaving Society and/or YMCA Swim Instructor Certification
