Nature & Scope

Reporting to the Food Service Director or Lead Cook, the Cook will work onsite at YMCA Wanakita in Haliburton Ontario.

The incumbent is responsible for the preparation of high-quality food in a timely, efficient, sanitary and consistent manner. The Cook must be prepared to work in a fast-paced, high-pressure work environment, while maintaining the organizational ability to identify and act on job duties quickly and effectively. The Cook must be prepared to work as a team member in a dynamic workplace and follow all safety procedures.

The successful candidate ensures that the camp dining halls provide a variety of healthy food selections in accordance with nutritional and/or special dietary requirements. They operate within specified nutritional guidelines and maintain quality service in a clean, safe environment.

Responsibilities

- Adheres to established YMCA, Health Department and Ministry policies and procedures around menu planning, food preparation and storage.
- Responsible for the daily preparation of food items in the pantry, fry and/or stations or other areas of the kitchen.
- Prepares all food items as directed in a sanitary and timely manner.

Organizational Overview:

The YMCA of

Hamilton/Burlington/Brantford offers programs and services including health, fitness and recreation, family and children's services, camping and outdoor education, youth leadership development, a men's residence located in the Hamilton Downtown branch and international development education.

YMCA Wanakita, located in the Haliburton Highlands on Koshlong Lake, is a four season YMCA Camp and Outdoor Centre affiliated with the YMCA of Hamilton/Burlington/Brantford. Situated 2 ½ hours north of Toronto on a beautiful forested 1000 acre site, Wanakita operates (for the 10 weeks in and around July and August) as a summer residential children's camp, a summer day camp and a summer family camp. From September to June, Wanakita operates as an Outdoor Education, Recreation and Retreat Centre for schools, colleges, universities, families, adults, businesses, clubs and other special interest groups. Wanakita currently serves over 150 different groups annually.

YMCA Wanakita maintains 130 buildings and has accommodation and dining for up to 700 people during the summer months and up to 250 in the winter; programs and equipment for swimming, canoeing, kayaking, sailing, cross country skiing, snow shoeing, high/low ropes courses, wilderness and environmental programs, crafts, performing arts and more. Wanakita offers outdoor experiences to over 13,000 participants annually. Currently employed are 12 full time staff members with seasonal staff support ranging from 14 - 180 employees. Over 250 volunteers a year are also involved in Wanakita's success.





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Responsibilities continued

- Follows recipes, portion controls, and presentation specifications as set by the Food Service Director or Lead Cook.
- Restocks all items as needed throughout shift.
- Cleans and maintains station in practicing good safety, sanitation, organizational skills.
- Has understanding and knowledge to properly use and maintain all equipment in station.
- Follows proper reporting procedures for accidents and incidents to ensure follow-up and prevention.
- Stay productive at all times and prepare for future needs as time allows.
- Demonstrate flexibility and volunteer to fill open shifts as required by variations in staffing.
- Occasional supervision of 2 to 4 part-time kitchen staff.
- <u>Directs and trains other workers, but receives supervisory review of completed work.</u>
- Ability to lift up to 50lbs.
- Receive and store food supplies, equipment, and utensils in refrigerators, cupboards, and other storage areas.
- Stock cupboards and refrigerators.
- Remove trash and clean kitchen garbage containers.
- Carry food supplies, equipment, and utensils to and from storage and work areas.

- Safe Food Handling certification
- Standard First Aid and CPR-C
- Working knowledge of Canada's Food Guide
- Two years of experience working in food services
- Current (within 6 months of contract start date) vulnerable sector screening is a condition of employment
