Nature & Scope

The Groundskeeper-General Maintenance position reports to YMCA Wanakita's Facility Services Manager. The incumbent will perform semi-skilled work in the maintenance, care, and modification of YMCA Wanakita grounds and landscapes which includes the operation of electrical and gasoline powered tools, machines and vehicles. This role works in a customer service environment in supporting YMCA Wanakita's programs through the upkeep and maintenance of Wanakita's physical site.

Responsibilities

- Operate electric and gasoline powered equipment, machines and vehicles, including grass cutting equipment, chainsaws, ride-on lawnmowers and pickup-trucks
- Perform ongoing upkeep of Wanakita's physical site through maintaining a neat and manicured lawn through the use of grass cutting equipment
- Perform ongoing maintenance as directed including changing light bulbs, painting walls, basic woodwork, plumbing and repairs
- Safely and efficiently operates vehicles in transporting equipment, delivering supplies and collecting and disposing of garbage
- Performs and documents monthly Health and Safety/Life Safety requirements as required
- Required to physically lift weights of approximately 50 pounds on a frequent basis ie. garbage removal, furniture/equipment moving
- Required to climb and work from ladders ranging from 6-foot step ladder – 20+ foot extension ladders
- Performs cleaning duties as assigned including but not limited to cleaning bathrooms, dining facilities
- Requires a full range of physical motion in order to operate equipment, access facilities, including frequent bending, stooping, kneeling and reaching, working outdoors in all elements
